As you know if you will know if you've been reading this newsletter, Toastmasters District 91 UK South, Spring Conference is being held over the weekend of the 12th, 13th and 14th of May 2023. Of course, this is centred around the 4 District contests, keynotes and other great features and learning opportunities. But it is also important to recognise that the centrepiece of the event happens on Saturday with the District Council Meeting.

If you are a Club Officer, either President or a VPE you are automatically a member of District Council and you would have received an invitation to join us at this event from our Admin Manager Amy Jones. It is one of your official responsibilities as a Club Officer to attend this event.

All voting District Council members ensure that you complete your registration to attend the District Council meeting by 19:00 on Friday 11 May.

District Council Members have been provided with a registration link for in-person or online attendance via Formal Notice. Please

Club Elections: Some useful information for all D91 Clubs!



Have you noticed that we are approaching a exciting time of succession planning?

Before a transition/handover happens, the club election, which most clubs hold in May, should run according to the recommended procedure. If you have not had a Club election then this information is especially for you:

We suggest that all current Club officers take the following into due consideration:

 Ensure that the date of your club's AGM is communicated to all members (usually the first meeting in May) In addition to elections, the state of club's finances to be presented and make it a fun event and consider recognition and a celebratory event

- For club's with annual elections, a Club President cannot be re-elected for a subsequent term
- The Club President and Club Treasurer should be different members for good governance
- If the office of Immediate Past President is vacant, the Club President appoints another member in good standing to chair the committee
- All Club Officer roles are elected, not appointed


